THE KILLUMINATI FOUNDATION uses pictures for documentation purposes and may use them in fundraising activities. Because of the difficulties in making a determination on each case, THE KILLUMINATI FOUNDATION requires at least two pictures in order to consider funding. These pictures should include a clear frontal head shot and a full side body shot (including tail). There should be something in the picture (a person, for instance) that gives us a frame of reference on the size of the dog. Additional pictures may be required at THE KILLUMINATI FOUNDATION 's discretion. A good picture may mean the difference between getting an application approved or denied and a good picture will speed up the process. We cannot approve any dog for funding without pictures. We realize it is not always possible to get a clear picture; not all dogs cooperate. We have put together a few pictures here to show the poses that are helpful.
